**ANNUAL MUSKETRY COURSE.**

W. T. Astle, Whangateau, score 59.

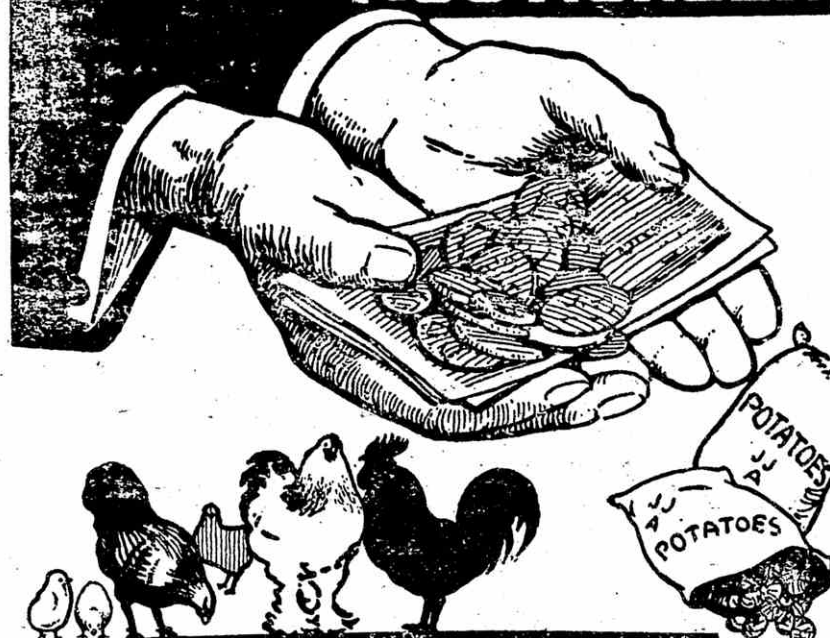

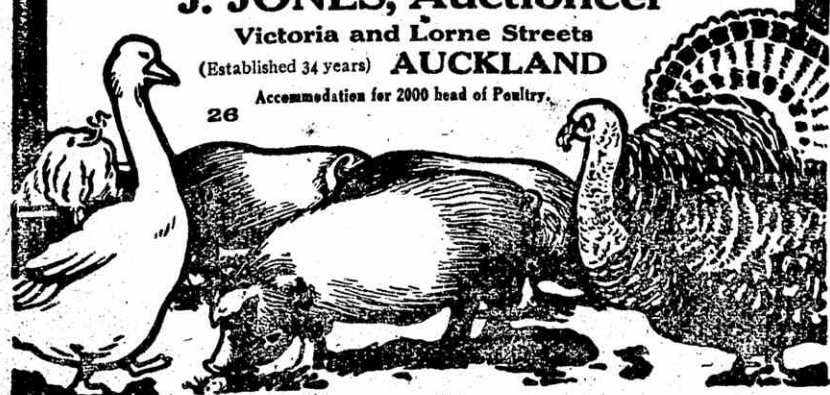

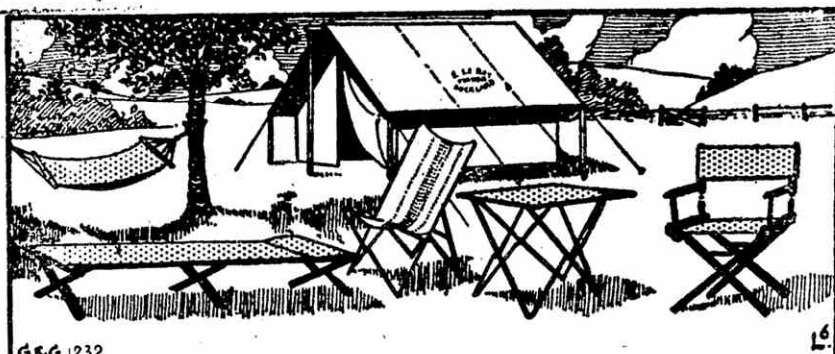
